## 2017 Year End Report of Audits of the WMWI Metro Recycling and Disposal Facility

JSA Environmental (JSA) has maintained a Contract with the City of Franklin (City) to provide Professional Engineering Services, in regards to the Waste Management Wisconsin Inc. Metro Recycling and Disposal Facility (Metro), since November of 2004. During that time JSA has reported to the Waste Facility Monitoring Committee (WFMC), providing the following services:

- Attendance to all WFMC Meetings
- Auditing of the Operations and Construction of the Waste Facility (Metro)
- Monitoring of odor conditions on and about the Waste Facility, including maintenance of an Odor Complaints Database.

JSA performed twenty four (24) audits of the Metro Facility during 2017. JSA conducts audits on a semimonthly schedule, a practice established in July of 2006. No additional audits were necessary, nor conducted during 2017<sup>1</sup>. In conjunction with operational audits there were two(2) construction audits. There were five(5) audits that were rescheduled due to no management being present.

All audits were performed in the presence of Metro Facility staff; either Travis Thorson, District Manager or Dan Otzelberger, Site Engineer. Audits were performed during operational hours of the facility including two "closing" audits, conducted at closing hours of the landfill; and one "opening" audits, conducted prior too and during the landfill morning opening.

Audits are recorded on "Audit Forms", approved by the WFMC and Metro. The form is reviewed by both auditor and a Metro representative at the end of each audit prior to signing by both parties. Audit observations are supported by photographs taken in conjunction with the audit. Should a compliance issue be observed it is recorded as an "Action Item" and included on a tallying list of action items for the year. In addition to the audit form, audit photographs, and action item list; a summary of the audit observations is created and included in the final deliverable document. The

deliverable audit document is placed upon the JSA Web page; <a href="https://www.JSAcivil.com/pages/audit/Franklin">www.JSAcivil.com/pages/audit/Franklin</a>. The summary of the 2017 Metro audits is in a format to match the recording completed on each Audit Form, reflecting the changes with the new form.

#### Weather Conditions

The weather conditions during the audit were recorded visually and from the weather stations within the area of the landfill. In 2017 all weather data was recorded from National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), via their web page at <a href="www.noaa.gov.">www.noaa.gov.</a>.

Precipitation events are monitored as well, these events have an impact on the structural integrity of the site's slopes, drainage ways, and basins. Wet cover materials have a tendency to seal in gas and dry conditions have a tendency to allow it to escape. Weather conditions also impact maintenance, access, and use of the site.

### Equipment used in Landfill Operation

The Metro facility had one waste compactor and two bulldozers in operation on the working face of the landfill for the majority of audits. When using site soil and/or recovered tipped soils for daily and intermediate cover the site employed the use of an excavator and haul truck to move soils recovered from Phase 6 & 7 or the borrow area. One water truck was available and used during dry dusty conditions. A bulldozer was in use in Phases 6&7 for the management of soil loads and some special wastes.

The Metro facility does not possess a street sweeper; however they have maintained a contract with a sweeping company to sweep US 45, and site roads three times per week. The sweeping events may not have occurred three times every week, however there were no Action Items pertaining to road conditions outside and within the site. Though no Action Items, there were two audits that recorded tracking from the entrance on US 45 and one audit recorded tracking on 8 Mile Road from the Residential Drop-off site.

### Working Face

Metro maintains a working face that fluctuates in size, though rarely larger than one half acre. Waste volumes dropped off in 2008, waste production is known to be dependent on the economy; lower volume equates to smaller working faces; as waste volumes have equalized over the last 7 years (~1,500 tons per day) so has the consistency of working face size. Weather conditions impact the working face size as well; during inclement weather the working face would be smaller. In 2017 the site employed the use of Working faces that were over a half acre in size, but thinly spread waste to maximize compaction on slopes. Due to the overlay(Phase 8) between the Clear Water Pond Expansion(Phase 9) and the nearly filled Phase 7; the working face has been placed on a slope to equalize elevations.

The facility maintained a working face for Municipal Solid Waste (MSW), Construction Demolition wastes (C&D), and special wastes in the Phases 6, 7, 8, and 9. During 2017, a large volume of cover soil was stockpile on the Eastern end of Phase 7. Phases 8 and 9 were the predominant location of Working Faces in 2017. Phase 6 was also the location of Working Faces for soils and asbestos only.

### **Cover Material**

The daily cover used by Metro consists of recovered soils, site soils, foundry sands, and MRF seconds. In 2017 the site was soil rich for cover and the use of cover was greatly improved. Use of soil (recovered or site) was the predominant material used for daily cover, especially in Phases 8 & 9. The facility has a large volume of recovered soils, previously tipped as a waste, to excavate and use

as cover along with more soil loads. Waste soil that is acceptable for daily cover can be received, soil loads, and stockpiled for immediate use; other waste soils require treatment prior to beneficial reuse.

### Leachate Management

Metro has the ability to recirculate leachate through a pipe system, buried in the waste, along with disposing of excess volumes through a pre-treatment plant to an MMSD force main. The construction of Phase 8, the overlay between Phases 6,7, and 9, was completed in 2016; which included the construction and connection of the Phase 8's leachate collection system. The collection system is unique in that access to the system, and others, required the placement of a manhole in the center of the Phase. The manhole had to be constructed prior to the placement of waste and rises eighty feet above the liner of the landfill; it is clearly seen in site photos. The manhole construction was completed in April of 2017.

Metro has a permit to receive liquid wastes, but similar to MSW the volume of waste has declined and was lower in 2016 than observed in previous years<sup>2</sup>. The facility did not recirculate leachate in 2017.

### Gas Monitoring & Management System

Metro operates four (4) engines and one (1) turbines to destruct landfill gas (LFG). In addition the site has one emergency flare. The system had numerous improvements, maintenance, and repairs over the year. The Auxiliary Flare that was installed in 2005 was relocated to the center of the landfill footprint and is lit when the facility needs more destruction volume.

The facility has not been able to operate all of its destructive devices throughout the year due to poor gas quality or quantity; but the gas production is higher than in 2016. In 2016 a turbine was taken offline and has not been restored. Currently, the site has more than enough "destruct" capacity in the four engines, one turbine, and flare to manage LFG generated at the facility. The flare was in use during nine(9) audits in 2017 to meet the destruction requirements of the system. There were other times the flare was lit in 2017, but not during auditing.

### Surface Water Management

Metro maintained its four basins throughout 2017 and thousands of feet of conveyances. Ditch cleaning had been an issue, but not an Action Item throughout 2016 and 2017. Partial ditch cleaning was done in third quarter of 2017. However, the ditches on the north boundary of Phase 9 and the South boundary of Phase 6 & 7 had reduced free board due to silt.

### **Odor Control**

Odors during audits were detected off site on one (1) occasions and eight (8) occasions on site. The off site odor was along 112<sup>th</sup> Street and was defined as an LFG odor. There was one recorded odor complaint in 2017.

There were several odor complaints made directly to JSA in 2017 regarding odors on US 45 that could have been generated by either facility<sup>3</sup>. In each instance the occurrence was discussed with landfill staff and if a potential source was identified the facility staff addressed it. Odor complaints dropped off following site improvements.

Metro did not implement any odor control activities or substances in 2017 other than placement of cover. As previously recorded, the cover conditions were improved in 2017.

Odor complaints made to the Metro Facility totaled one (1) in 2017.

### Special Waste Handling

Waste profiles, sampling, and protocols are done off site from the Metro Facility. This item remains on the audit should a new waste be accepted. Common special wastes received are asbestos, biosoils, and liquids. The facility tipped asbestos and bio-soils in Phase 6 only. The asbestos is entombed and untouched, bio-soil is stock piled for treatment and future re-use. Metro received a permit to receive liquid wastes in 2009 and continues the practice to do so. During 2017 Metro received liquid loads sporadically.

### Litter Control

Metro implements three litter fences about the active area. Two are tall, over twelve feet, set about Phases 8 and 9, the other is set along the perimeter along 112<sup>th</sup> Street. The third fence is a six foot mesh fence. These fences are specifically for litter; with additional security perimeter fencing that also captures litter. Temporary fences are placed and removed as the landfill rises. All 2017 audits recorded litter on site, predominantly trapped in a fence. Litter was recorded seventeen (17) times offsite.

JSA records offsite litter whenever present on each audit, if the litter condition is present at the next audit it is recorded as an Action Item. On January 31 there was still excessive offsite litter in the trees along 112<sup>th</sup> street that was also present during the previous audit in 2016. The Action Item was addressed by June 14 when the litter was removed from the trees. Again, on November 28 excessive litter was recorded on two consecutive audits in the trees and the fields of 112<sup>th</sup> Street. The second action item was still open at the end of 2017.

The offsite litter occurs due to the proximity of the landfill footprint and 112th Street.

Two Action Items recorded in 2017 due to offsite litter conditions.

### Vehicle Impacts

Metro's contract with Resource Recovery Systems (street sweeping) has greatly improved the conditions on US 45. Interior road conditions are deteriorating, but still serviceable and not creating unmanageable conditions offsite. On site roads were regularly recorded to be gritty or muddy based on weather conditions; additionally the perimeter road has become rutted and the occasional pothole. US 45 and 8 Mile road were clean with relation to Metro activities; there were two (2) audits that recorded tracking from the entrance on US 45 and one (1) audit recorded tracking on 8 Mile Road from the Residential Drop-off site.

### Inspection of incoming waste

Metro uses numerous cameras, view able by the scale operator in addition to recording, to monitor both truck activities and contents. Each equipment operator on the working face is able to observe the waste components when tipped from the haul vehicles. Metro does not make use of spotters nor does it have working faces that are not monitored by Metro staff.

All Wisconsin permitted landfills are required to perform a random load inspection for every 5,000 tons of waste received. In 2017 proper random load inspection performance was recorded for the majority of audits.

### Rejected Loads

There were no rejected loads recorded in 2017.

### **Contractors Audit**

In 2016 Metro had New Berlin Excavating, Fence Erectors, Cornerstone Engineering, Landfill Gas Driller, and a landscaper to perform slope seeding on site. The activities of the contractors were recorded during the audits.

In December of 2017 the excavation of the Expansion Northwest began. JSA was present to record two (2) construction audits of the excavation. Both audits were done during simple excavation activities.

The majority of contractor activity in 2017 was the completion of the manhole and improvements of the gas collection system.

### Action Items

There were two action items, both related to offsite litter, in 2017. It can be expected that offsite litter will continue to be an issue until Phases 8 & 9 reach final elevation on the East slope.

JSA records and discusses potential issues with the facility management to prevent development of future action items.

There was one odor complaint in 2017. The Metro Facility did not implement the use of any odor controls beyond waste placement and cover in 2017.

Attached is the weekly audit report of activities at the Waste Management Metro Recycling and Disposal Facility for the week of January 8, 2017. The Audit was performed at 1:38 PM, on January 13, 2017 by Jo Spear Jr. in the presence of Travis Thorson, District Manager.

The following bullet items were developed from the **Operations** Audit:

- Weather overcast; threatening snow storm
- Working face moving about surface of Phase 8
  - Relocating working face as needed to level surface of Phase 8
  - Filling depressions with waste, then applying daily cover
- Special wastes are being tipped in Phase 6
- One compactor, two bulldozers and excavator in use on site
- Daily cover composed of soils from tipping stockpile
- All leachate discharging to MMSD; no recirculation
- No flares, 1 Turbine and 4 Engines in operation
  - Flare will be lit later today due to failure of one engine
  - Gas destruction 2.800 cfm
  - One shut down since last audit
  - Flare was lit while 4<sup>th</sup> engine was repaired
  - Engine was down due to bad cylinder
- Numerous snow events since last audit; greater than 1" accumulation
  - Site surface water frozen
  - No new erosion
- No odors
- Liquid loads received on 1/12/17
- Litter present on-site and off-site
  - 4 Pickers at work
  - High winds in early January distributed litter East of 112<sup>th</sup> Street and site slopes
- US 45 and 8-Mile Rd heavily slated in expectation of more snow
- Tipping scale camera and 3 equipment operators at work; no spotter
- Average tonnage received reduced to 930 TPD
  - Waste being tipped is MSW and Special Wastes

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



Attached is the weekly audit report of activities at the Waste Management Metro Recycling and Disposal Facility for the week of January 29, 2017. The Audit was performed at 1:44 PM, on **January 31, 2017** by Jo Spear Jr. in the presence of Travis Thorson, District Manager.

The following bullet items were developed from the **Operations** Audit:

- Overcast, with some sun brisk
- Working face for MSW at Eastern edge of Phase 8
  - Filling depressions between Phase 8 &9
- Bio soils, asbestos and other special wastes tipping in Phase 6
- One compactor, two bulldozers and two excavators active on site
- Site soils in use for daily cover
- All leachate discharging to MMSD; no recirculation
- One flare, 1 Turbine and 4 Engines in operation
  - Flare lit due to temporary spike in methane volume
  - Gas destruction consistent (with exception of spike) at 2,670 cfm
  - One shut down since last audit.
- Several snow events since last audit; more than 1"
  - Some thawing of surfaces; basins still frozen
  - Snow covering slopes prevents erosion observation
- No odors on, or off-site
- No liquid loads
- Litter present on, and off-site
- Litter has been difficult to control due to several days of high wind
  - Two litter pickers working today
- US 45 has been swept and 8-Mile Rd is clean; site roads are gritty
- Tipping scale camera and 3 equipment operators at work; no spotter
- Average tonnage received 1,200 TPD
  - Waste being tipped is MSW, foundry sand and C&D
  - No rejected loads
  - Random load inspection 1/27/17




Landfill Audit Map City of Franklin Project No. 1036, 10056

































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



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

Attached is the weekly audit report of activities at the Waste Management Metro Recycling and Disposal Facility for the week of December 17, 2017. The Audit was performed at 8:20 AM, on **December 18, 2017** by Jo Spear Jr. in the presence of Daniel Otzelberger, Site Engineer.

#### The following bullet items were developed from the Operations Audit:

- Overcast, occasional snow; low 40°s
- Working face above flare and below manhole in Phase 8
  - Bio-soils and Asbestos delivered to working face at West end of Phase 6
- One compactor and two bulldozers in use on site
- · Incoming soil loads used for daily cover
- All leachate discharging to MMSD; no recirculation
- One flare, one Turbine and 3 Engines in operation
  - Flare in use pending repair of broken engine
  - Engine shutdown for replacement of crankshaft
  - Gas destruction 2.400 cfm
  - · One shut down since last audit
  - New wells currently being added to system
- Small snow accumulation from multiple flurries since last audit
  - Site frozen
- Odors on-site; some off-site
  - Gas odor strongest along Eastern boundary
- No liquid loads
- Litter present on, and off-site
  - Litter mostly on Eastern edge of site and along 112<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Two litter pickers working today
- US 45 and 8-Mile Rd clean
  - Site roads rough and pot-holed
- Tipping scale camera and 3 equipment operators at work; no spotter

- Receiving average of 1,300 TPD
  - · Waste being tipped is MSW, soils and smaller volume of special wastes




